Subject: Highway Department report for the month of April 2025

Highway trucks traveled 4096 miles and used 521.7 gallons of diesel fuel and 121 gallons of gasoline. Fuel cost for the month was \$2250.09 diesel and \$486.30 gasoline.

Street sweepers traveled 83 miles and used 73.6 gallons of diesel fuel. Fuel cost for the month was \$306.23.

All other equipment used 146.16 gallons of diesel fuel and 19.94 gallons of gasoline. Fuel cost for the month was \$608.01 diesel and \$63 gasoline.
